Partnership for inclusion of neurodiversity in schools (PINS)



Greenwich has been chosen to be a part of a national pilot programme led by the NHS and DfE to increase understanding of neuro diversity in primary schools.

The programme is a joint programme with the Council, Parent Forum, Health and schools and works with school leadership teams, parents, governing bodies and individual practitioners to create lasting change in the understanding of neuro diversity. 20 Greenwich schools were selected from over 30 and the intention is to share learning across our whole community of schools.

The Forum are leading the work with parents and schools and have already visited 18 of them and are developing exciting plans. We will keep all updated as the project progresses next term....

Greenwich Parent Carer Participation Forum

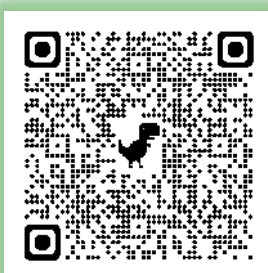
