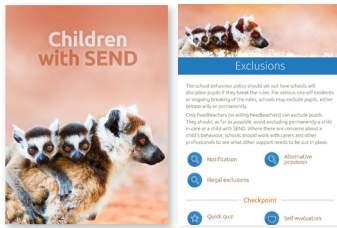

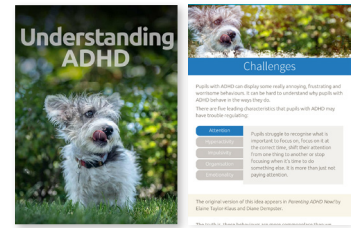




- ▲ **Children with SEND**

This course helps parents and foster carers support their children with speech, language and communication needs (SLCN).



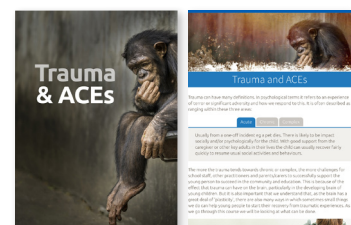
- ▲ **Managing Learning Anxiety**
This course suggests steps to help with children's wellbeing and how to address barriers to learning and develop resilience as part of your day-to-day practice.



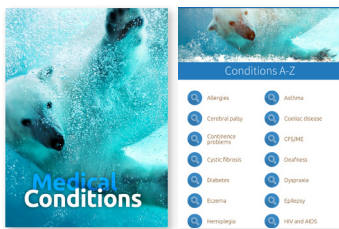

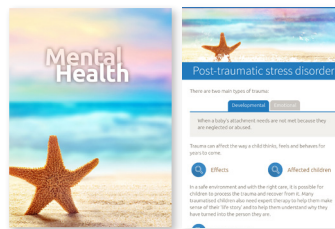

An introduction to the effects of trauma and adverse childhood experiences, with ideas for supporting young people and increasing their resilience.



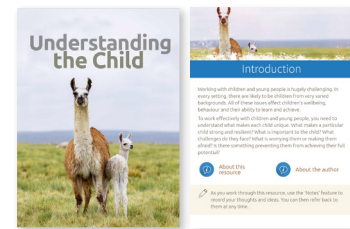
▲ Medical Conditions

Discussing the general issues surrounding long-term conditions and disability, plus information on many specific conditions.



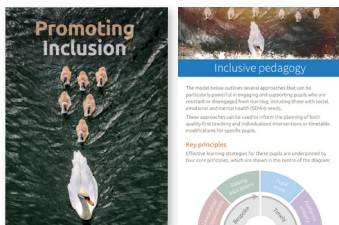
▲ Mental Health
