## **Full Time Education**

Below are some links which provide further information on each of the options for staying in full time education:

<u>A level (at sixth form</u> college, Further education <u>college or a UTC)</u>

At the end of year 11, it's time to think about your options for the future and to make decisions for the next year or two. Once you have left school, there are 3 main pathways you can take: Stay in full time education Start an apprenticeship Spend 20 hours or more a week working or volunteering, alongside parttime education, or training

**Apprenticeships** 

**Apprenticeships** are real jobs which combine work with training and study. You can apply for an apprenticeship whilst at school. You'll earn a wage, gain a qualification and experience, and can put what you have learnt into practice. In some cases, you may be offered a job at the end of your apprenticeship.
